



NIGMS Human Genetic Cell Repository: Donor Request to Assign Back-to-Submitter Rights

As the submitter of your own specimen or that of a family member, if the specimen results in a cell line that is accepted for inclusion in the NIGMS Repository online catalog, you may designate a qualified investigator of your choice to receive without charge a *back-to-submitter* sample. This *back-to-submitter* sample can be the cell line/DNA derived from your submission or a sample of any other cell line/DNA sample in the NIGMS Repository. Please note that induced pluripotent stem cell (iPSC) lines cannot be shipped as *back-to-submitter* samples.

Your sample may be assigned to a research investigator or collaborator. He/she will need to pay the shipping costs and must have a current Material Transfer Agreement (MTA) form on file at Coriell.

Please enter the requested information for the cell lines for which you have chosen to assign the *back-to-submitter* rights to an investigator.
